A site risk assessment must be documented for each jobsite that a MEWP will be used on. The risk assessment must:

Define the work

Identify controls •

Evaluate the risks

- Communicate
- Select an appropriate MEWP



MEWPs - ANSI A.92 2020

Changes to the ANSI A.92 in 2020 now require that operators be familiarized with the MEWP prior to operating it.

Familiarization

- Location of the weather-resistant compartment for the manual •
- The purpose and function of all controls
- Safety devices and operating characteristics specific to the aerial platform

Training

Employees must be trained every three years on how their actions can affect lift stability and how to:

- Use fall protection and the location of fall protection anchors
- Safely use MEWP accessories they are assigned to use
- Adhere to the safety plan and avoid site-specific hazards
- Complete emergency procedures in line with manufacturer's warnings and safety information
